Agreement

- 1.) All Sewer Installers must obtain an approved permit to install a sewer connection. Failure to do so shall result in fines and penalties in accordance with the “REGULATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS AND FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC SEWERS IN THE TOWN OF WILBRAHAM MASSACHUSETTS” Effective Date: February 2009.
- 2.) Sewer Installers shall not commence any work until it is confirmed that all fees have been paid.
- 3.) All Sewer Installers must obtain an approved trench permit (\$50.00) from the Board of Health. The Board of Health Agent is Lorri McCool. She can be reached at 454-5155.
- 4.) Sewer Installers shall be responsible for abiding by the Town of Wilbraham’s Sewer Regulations. A copy of said document can be obtained in the Engineering Department or on the Town website (www.wilbraham-ma.gov).
- 5.) Sewer Installers must acknowledge that the installation and use of sump pumps are illegal in Wilbraham and they will be held accountable if they installed the pump.
- 6.) A \$25.00 sewer inspection fee and a \$25.00 administrative fee shall be paid in advance of the inspection.
- 7.) Sewer Installers are responsible for notifying the Wilbraham Water Department at 596-2800 ext, 208 or the Water Superintendent Michael Framarin at 530-4502, forty-eight (48) hours in advance to mark out any water lines prior to beginning work.
- 8.) All sewer pump systems must be inspected by the Town electrical inspector. Proof of electrical inspection must be provided at time of sewer inspection.
- 9.) To arrange a sewer inspection please call 596-2800 ext 208 or Ron Lavoie at 348-4415.
- 10.) At the time of inspection, an as-built must be presented or no inspection will take place.
