The Board of Selectmen will hold an executive session for the following purposes: per M.G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a) (1) to discuss the discipline or dismissal of, or complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual; per M.G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a) (2) to conduct strategy sessions in preparation for negotiations with nonunion personnel--Town Administrator, Acting Fire Chief; per M.G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a) (2) to conduct contract negotiations with nonunion personnel--Town Administrator; per M.G.L. c. 30A, § 21(a) (3) to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining with the UPSEU Local 424M; whereas discussion an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining position of the Board of Selectmen, and the Chairman so declares.
