*Amended Motion - Motion made by Mr. Stogner that boys Falcon Lax pay their 2018 back fee of \$2500 prior to using any field rentals through park and rec for the 2019 season. Second by Mr. Trebbe, all in favor.*

*Motion made by Mr. Zimmer that girl's lax pay their \$2500 fee for 2018 prior to any field usage, Second by Mr. Trebbe, all in favor.*

Rec Commission is working to be consistent and fair for all programs that were asked to pay the \$2500.

Falcon Youth Football and Friends of Recreation  
Baseball – good shape with budget, meet on a monthly basis, need updated equipment for rec and comp teams, fundraiser upcoming with Dunkin Donuts, Rec doing registration for rec baseball. Numbers are around the same as previous years. 7 comp teams, 6 rec teams, over 200 kids involved with rec/comp players. Winter Clinic was a success, over 50 kids, \$1000 made, great feedback, pitchers clinic coming up and catchers. Coaching clinic also with AP is a possibility. 11 members, one new member Ray Antaya.

Football – coaching apps sent out, pre planning stages, FYFA board is filled, plan is to not raise fees for 2019, players get full uniform and option to buy practice pants, fundraising is mostly done through calendar raffle for each player.
