Minutes of Meeting October 10, 2019

The Wilbraham Board of Water Commissioners called the meeting to order at 9:00AM at the Wilbraham Town Hall. Commissioners present were: Tom Pilarcik and Rik Alvarez. Also present was Vincent Pafumi.

MINUTES:

Motion was made and unanimously voted to accept Minutes of the September 5, 2019 meeting and August 8, 2019 Special Meeting.

BUDGET: The DOR closed books. We have retained earnings of \$210,000.00

MWRA:

The Daily Flows for the Town of Wilbraham from the MWRA. They are still up. Beginning to slow down. They are higher than the last two (2) years. Overall we have had a good summer.

WATER DEPARTMENT BUSINESS:

Meter reading is done.

Brookmont Pump Station. The driveway has been paved, including a berm. The fire hydrant has been painted.

Glenn Drive. The water department anticipates resuming work next week.

Old Coach Road. A fire hydrant was replaced. Today we will be looming and seeding.

Vincent Pafumi advised that he and Water Commissioner James Dunbar met with Jeff Cyr, Water Department Superintendent for South Hadley District 1. Mr. Cyr advised that Granby, Ma was looking for permission to tap in to their water system. The line would go up to Granby by Route 202. This would be a three (3) phase construction. Looking for permission from Wilbraham and Chicopee. Basically, we are okay. Our system is capable of handling it. We are upstream from them and we feel that it wouldn't be a problem. This situation is raising eyebrows, as Hampden could not tie in. There will be another sit down with Mr. Cyr sometime next month.

CA Turner a leak detection company will be coming to town. They will be doing 40 miles or approximately half of the town. It will take approximately 3 days to complete. They will give us a print out, spreadsheet. This will make our DEP/CRA report more efficient.

Old Business:

Plan to do skid on McIntosh at a cost of \$40,000.00. In a bit of a dilemma. Looking at holding off until maybe in the spring.
