Public Notice

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 111, Sections 150A and 150A 1/2 and the regulations promulgated thereunder, 310 CMR 16.00 "Site Assignment Regulations for Solid Waste Facilities," an application for a site assignment modification has been filed with the Wilbraham Board of Health and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) for the proposed modification of the existing site assignment of the Western Recycling Solid Waste Handling Facility, located at 120 Old Boston Road, Wilbraham MA 01095.

The existing site assignment for 23.2 acres of the 55.5-acre parcel is for use as a processing and handling facility that accepts, recycles and transfers municipal solid waste (MSW), construction and demolition (C&D) waste, and lightly-contaminated soils at a maximum rate of 645 tons/day and 156,000 tons per year. The proposed modification to the site assignment will allow the facility to expand the hours of operation as well as to accept and transfer these materials at a capacity of up to 2,000 tons per day and 612,000 tons per year. MassDEP shall receive comments on the proposed facility site for 21 days from the date of the public notice requirements having been met. All comments regarding the assignment of this site should reference the DEP File #19-339-007C, and be mailed to: Solid Waste Section Chief, MA Department of Environmental Protection, 436 Dwight Street, Springfield, MA 01103.

The applicant may modify the application for the initial forty (40) days of the review period where such modifications are deemed not to be major modifications. MassDEP shall issue a Report on Suitability within sixty (60) days of the date of the public notice.
