

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
SEPTEMBER 4, 1990

In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School, at 7:30 p.m. Moderator Donald F. Bready determined that a quorum was present and the call of the meeting was read by Town Clerk Mary A. Irla.

Tellers appointed and sworn in by the Moderator were: Robert Glidden & Allan G. Peck.

ARTICLE 1: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously that the Town appropriate a sum not to exceed \$150,000 for the purposes of constructing a sewer line to connect certain residences in the vicinity of West Colonial Road directly into the City of Springfield sewer system; that to meet this appropriation the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, be authorized to borrow funds pursuant to Chapter 44, Section 7 of the General Laws; and that the Board of Selectmen be authorized to assess betterments pursuant to Chapter 80 and Chapter 83 of the General Laws against each parcel of land receiving a benefit from the project in order to recover 100% of all project costs, less any amount of state or federal grant reimbursements for the project which are made available within the statutory time to apply for and grant abatements.

ARTICLE 2: Petitioned Article. VOTED UNANIMOUSLY TO MOVE NO ACTION.

(To see if the Town of Wilbraham will raise by general taxation, or appropriate from available funds, an amount necessary to fund one-third of the cost of a project to connect certain homes on West Colonial Rd. to the City of Springfield's sewer system.)

ARTICLE 3: VOTED BY A MAJORITY TO MOVE NO ACTION

(To see if the Town will vote to appropriate an additional sum of money from the certified Undesignated Fund Balance to fund Fiscal Year 1991 municipal expenditures)

ARTICLE 4: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously that the Town transfer the sum of \$14,000 from the FY 1991 Solid Waste Expense budget to the FY 1991 Solid Waste Salary Budget.

ARTICLE 5: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously (100 Yes - No 0) that the Town appropriate the sum of \$3,431.75 from the Undesignated Fund Balance to compensate Robert Ritchie, Esquire, of Amherst, Massachusetts for services rendered to the Town in a prior fiscal year.
