

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
DECEMBER 13, 1990

In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School.

At 7:30 p.m. Moderator Donald F. Bready noted that the quorum of 50 registered voters was not present and after a reasonable waiting time he would consider a motion to adjourn or dissolve the meeting if the quorum was not met.

It was determined by the Selectmen and the Moderator that since the Article to be voted on had already been passed by the majority of the towns in the County, Wilbraham would automatically be included, therefore, a motion to dissolve the meeting rather than adjourn would be accepted by the moderator.

After an explanation on the procedure to dissolve was explained to the voting body by the Moderator, a motion was made and seconded to dissolve the meeting and was approved unanimously.

The Article that was to be voted on follows:

Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to accept the provisions of Section 22D of Chapter 32, which establishes various options relating to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Contributory Retirement System; or take any other action relative thereto.
