

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
FEBRUARY 27, 1991

In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School at 7:30 p.m. Town Moderator Donald F. Bready determined that a quorum was present and the call of the meeting was read by Town Clerk Mary A. Irla.

ARTICLE 1: Voted by a Majority (Yes 50, No 45) that the Town petition the General Court to enact and accept legislation as follows:

Proposed Legislation

An Act Combining the Office of Town Treasurer and the Office of Town Collector in the Town of Wilbraham into the Office of Treasurer-Collector and Authorizing the Board of Selectmen to Appoint the Treasurer-Collector. Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of chapter forty-one of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, office of treasurer and the office of collector in the Town of Wilbraham shall be combined to establish the office of Treasurer-Collector and thereafter the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Wilbraham shall appoint a Treasurer-Collector for an indefinite term.

SECTION 2: Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of this act, the incumbents in the offices of Treasurer and Collector upon the effective date of this act shall continue to hold said offices and to perform the duties thereof until an appointment of a Treasurer-Collector is made in accordance with section 1 of this act, and upon such appointment the terms of office of the treasurer and the office of collector shall terminate.

SECTION 3: This act shall take effect at Midnight May 3, 1991.

NOTE: The above legislation was approved by Acting Governor A. Paul Cellucci on April 16, 1991 and this act shall take effect on May 4, 1991.

ARTICLE 2: Voted Unanimously that the Town transfer a sum of \$2300.00 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the Fiscal Year 1991 Accounting Department Expense budget to the Fiscal Year 1991 Accounting Department Salary budget.

ARTICLE 3: Voted Unanimously to move no action. (Transfer of available funds to various other accounts)

ARTICLE 4: Voted Unanimously that the Town accept the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 83, Section 16A through 16F inclusive, regarding collection of sewer rates, charges, and interest thereon.

ARTICLE 5: Voted Unanimously that the Town authorize the imposition and collection of municipal charges and liens under G.L. Chapter 44, Section 28C (f), and Chapter 40, Section 58, in connection with solid waste user fees, including, but not limited to landfill sticker fees.
