

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
AUGUST 25, 1992

In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School. At 7:05 p.m. Town Moderator Arthur F. Dionne noted a quorum was present and led the body in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. The call of the meeting was read by Assistant Town Clerk Beverly J. Radner.

ARTICLE 1: Voted Unanimously that the Town adopt special parliamentary procedures for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980 (Proposition 2 1/2), as amended, and on file with the Town Clerk.

ARTICLE 2: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously that the Town amend Article 7 as approved by Annual Town Meeting on June 22, 1992, by the following amounts:

- Increase Budget #003, Selectmen Salaries, by \$20,588
- Decrease Budget #081, Insurance, by \$1,666
- Increase Budget #200, Local Schools, by \$26,306
- Increase Budget #201, Regional School, by \$11,960

and that the Town further amend Article 7 to appropriate the sum of \$15,429,602 to cover the necessary capital expenditures and operating expenses of the Town for Fiscal Year 1993 (July 1, 1992-June 30, 1993) per appropriations listed separately and incorporated hereby by reference, and to provide said appropriations as follows:

PETITIONED ARTICLE

ARTICLE 3: MOVED NO ACTION. (Motion read: Move that the Town appropriate out of available funds for the Hampden-Wilbraham Regional School District the sum, not to exceed \$77,000, in order to satisfy in full the Town of Wilbraham's share of the proposed Regional School District's Assessment, said additional appropriation to be funded by simultaneously reducing the appropriation, to the Reserve Fund, from the sum of \$100,000 to not less than \$23,000.) Finance Committee recommends no action.

ARTICLE 4: Finance Committee Recommends Voted Unanimously (Yes 72, No 0) that the \$41,800 authorization under Section 7 (3A) of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws as approved under Article 9 of the 1992 Annual Town Meeting for remodeling, reconstruction or making extraordinary repairs to public buildings is hereby amended as follows:

That \$26,800 is appropriated for remodeling, reconstructing or making extraordinary repairs to public buildings owned by the Town and \$15,000 is appropriated for construction of public buildings, including the cost of original equipment and furnishings; and that to meet these appropriations the Treasurer with the approval of the Selectmen is authorized to borrow \$26,800 under Section 7 (3A) of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws and \$15,000 under Section 7 (3) of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws.
