SEPTEMBER 9, 1993

In accordance with the warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School. At 7:10 p.m. Town Moderator Arthur F. Dionne noted a quorum was present and led the body in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. The call of the meeting was read by Town Clerk Mary A. Irla.

ARTICLE 1: Parliamentary Procedure: Voted Unanimously that the Town adopt Special Parliamentary Procedures for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Chapter 508 of the Acts of 1980 (Proposition 2 1/2), as amended, and on file with the Town Clerk.

ARTICLE 2: Budget Amendments: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously that the Town amend Article 12 as approved by Annual Town Meeting on June 12, 1993, by the following amounts:

Increase Budget #025, Accounting Salaries, by \$6,108,  
to be raised from State revenue sharing.

Increase Budget #200, Local Schools, by \$589,486,  
to be raised from State revenue sharing.

ARTICLE 3: Stabilization Fund: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously that the Town appropriate \$77,674, to be raised from taxation (\$53,873) and state revenue sharing (\$23,801), to the Stabilization Fund pursuant to section 5B of Chapter 40 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

ARTICLE 4. Regulation of Vendors: Voted Unanimously to **MOVE NO ACTION.**

A motion to dissolve the meeting was approved Unanimously at 7:25 p.m.
