

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 14, 1994

In accordance with the warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School. Town Moderator Arthur F. Dionne noted a quorum was present and the call of the meeting was read by Town Clerk Mary A. Irla.

Selectman Kevin Moriarty requested, from the Moderator, time to read a citation from the selectmen declaring Saturday, May 14, as Mary A. Irla Day, in appreciation for the 16 years she served as Town Clerk of Wilbraham, and wished her well on her retirement effective May 21, 1994.

Gale Candaras, Selectman, further presented the Town Clerk with a lovely bouquet of flowers and the voting body showed their approval with a standing ovation. Town Moderator Arthur F. Dionne added to the occasion with kind words of appreciation and the Town Clerk, totally surprised, thanked everyone for the presentation.

ARTICLE 1: Voted Unanimously, that the Town adopt special parliamentary procedures for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980 (Proposition 2 1/2), as amended, and on file with the Town Clerk.

ARTICLE 2: Funding Transfers: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously; pursuant to Section 33B of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws that the Town transfer the sum of:

\$2,800 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1994 Budgets 034, Treasurer/Collector Expenses (\$2,500) and 531, Council on Aging Expenses (\$300), to the FY 1994 Budget 487, Conservation Commission Salaries;

\$35,000 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1994 Budgets 103, Fire Expenses (\$700), and 081, General Insurance Expenses (\$34,300), to the FY 1994 Budget 103, Fire Salaries;

\$5,000 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1994 Budget 101, Police Salaries, to the FY 1994 Budget 101, Police Expenses;

\$4,500 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1994 Budget 081, General Insurance Expenses, to the FY 1994 Budget 301, Highway Salaries;

\$51,639 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1994 Budgets 025, Accounting Expenses (\$3,425), 077, Group Insurance Expenses (\$14,000), 081, General Insurance Expenses (\$14,014), 082, Surety Bond Expenses (\$425), 101, Police Salaries (\$2,500), 111, Central Dispatch Expenses (\$1,000), 531, Council on Aging Expenses (\$275), and 702, Interest Expenses (\$16,000), to FY 1994 Budget 301, Highway Expenses;

\$82 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1994 Budget 025, Accounting Expenses, to FY 1994 Budget 113, Inspectors Expenses;

\$280 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in FY 1994 Budget 101, Police Expenses to FY 1994 Budget 101, Police Out of State Travel;

\$5,000 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in FY 1994 Budget 61-450, Water Enterprise Fund Expenses, to FY 1994 Budget 61-450, Water Enterprise Fund Salaries; and

\$2,000 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1994 Budget 66-430, Solid Waste Enterprise Fund Expenses, to the FY 1994 Budget 66-430, Solid Waste Enterprise Fund Salaries.

ARTICLE 3: Receipts Reserved for Appropriation for Ambulance: Finance Committee Recommends. Voted Unanimously that the Town appropriate \$10,500 from Receipts Reserved for Appropriation for Ambulance, for Ambulance salaries, pursuant to Section 5, of Chapter 40 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

ARTICLE 4: Stabilization Fund: VOTED UNANIMOUSLY TO MOVE NO ACTION.

ARTICLE 5: Unpaid Bills of Previous Year: Finance Committee Recommends. 90% vote Required. Voted Unanimously that the Town vote to appropriate \$64,949 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds under Local Schools Expenses for the purpose of paying unpaid bills from FY 1993 for school operating costs pursuant to Section 64 of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

ARTICLE 6: Unpaid Bill of previous year. Finance Committee Recommends. 90% Vote required. Voted Unanimously that the Town appropriate \$608.16 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds under Dog Officer Expenses for the purpose of paying an unpaid bill from FY 1993 for electricity at the Dog Pound pursuant to Section 64 of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

Voted Unanimously to dissolve the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
