

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING**

April 29, 1996

In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School. Town Moderator Arthur F. Dionne noted a quorum was present and the call of the meeting was read by Town Clerk Beverly J. Radner.

**ARTICLE 1: Parliamentary Procedure:** Voted Unanimously that the Town adopt special parliamentary procedures for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980 (Proposition 2 1/2) as amended, and on file with the Town Clerk.

A motion was made by Selectman Frank Everton and seconded by Selectman Kevin Moriarty to wave the reading of the Parliamentary Procedures since it was just read for the Annual Town Meeting. Motion carried Unanimously.

**ARTICLE 2: Funding Transfers: Finance Committee Recommends.** Voted Unanimously, pursuant to Section 33B of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, that the Town transfer the sum of:

\$52,429 from the previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1996 Budgets 134, Accounting Expenses (\$1,000), 610 Library Expenses (\$1,150), 171, Conservation Commission Salaries (\$3,352), 138, Treasurer-Collector Expenses (\$10,000), 702, Interest Expenses (\$24,000), and 210, Police Salaries (\$12,927), to the FY 1996 Budget 420, Highway Expenses;

\$38,357 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 1996 Budget 301, Regional School Assessment, to the FY 1996 Budgets 220, Fire Salaries (\$20,000), 194, Group Insurance Expenses (\$3,325), 240, Dispatch Salaries (\$715), 192, Town Properties Expenses (\$5,510), 543, Veterans Expenses (\$1,082), 210 Police Expenses (\$125), 173, Board of Appeals Salaries (\$100), 196, Town Report Expenses (\$1,000), 199, Town Office Expenses (\$5,000) and 122, Selectmen Expenses (\$1,500);

\$9,000 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in FY 1996 Budget 210, Police Salaries, to the FY 1996 Budget 240, Dispatch Salaries;

\$3,000 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in FY 1996 Budget 60-440, Wastewater Expenses to the FY 1996 Budget 60-440, Wastewater Salaries.

**ARTICLE 3: Funding Transfer: Finance Committee Recommends.** Voted Unanimously that the Town transfer the sum of **\$18,750** from the FY 1996 Ambulance Special Revenue Fund to the FY 1996 Budget 220, Fire Salaries, pursuant to Section 33B of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

**ARTICLE 4: Insurance Proceeds: Finance Committee Recommends.** Voted Unanimously that the Town appropriate the sum of \$900 from the Insurance Reimbursement Account to FY 1996 Budget 192, Town Properties Expense in accordance with Section 53 of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

**ARTICLE 5: Free Cash: Finance Committee Recommends.** Voted Unanimously that the Town appropriate from Free Cash **\$54,900** to FY 1996 Budgets 122, Selectmen Expenses (**\$54,000**), and 192, Town Properties Expense (**\$900**).

**ARTICLE 6: Chapter 90 Anticipation Borrowing:** Voted Unanimously to move no action.

Voted Unanimously to dissolve the meeting at 7:30 PM.
