

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

May 6, 2002

In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School. At 7:25PM the Moderator, Arthur F. Dionne, noted a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Town Clerk Beverly J. Litchfield then read the call of the meeting.

ARTICLE 1. -Parliamentary Procedure: Finance Committee Recommends. Passing by a unanimous vote that the Town adopt special parliamentary procedures for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980 (Proposition 2½) as amended, and as set forth in a document entitled "Article 1, Exhibit A," on file with the Town Clerk.

ARTICLE 2. -Funding Transfers: Finance Committee Recommend. Pursuant to Section 33B of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, passing by unanimous vote that the Town transfer the sums of:

- \$20,060 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2002 Budget 220, Police Salaries to the FY 2002 Budgets 134, Accounting Expenses (\$1,000), 220, Police Expenses (\$5,210), 199, Town Office Expenses (\$3,284), 292, Dog Officer Expenses (\$500), 610, Library Expenses (\$3,225) and 194, Group Health Insurance (\$6,841);
- \$18,128 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2002 Budgets 134, Accounting Salaries (\$200), 240, Dispatch Salaries (\$4,200), 251, Inspector Salaries (\$3,728), 541, Council on Aging Salaries (\$3,000), 520, Recreation Salaries (\$2,000) and 700, Long Term Debt (\$5,000) to the FY 2002 Budgets 194, Group Health Insurance (\$14,659) and 420, Highway Expenses (\$3,469); and
- \$63,815 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2002 Budget 131, Reserve Fund to the FY 2002 Budget 420, Highway Expenses.

ARTICLE 3. -Receipts Reserved for Appropriation for Ambulance: Finance Committee Recommends. Passing by unanimous vote that the Town appropriate \$15,000 from Receipts Reserved for Appropriation for Ambulance to Ambulance personal services and operating costs, pursuant to Section 5 of Chapter 40 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

The Motion to dissolve the Special Town Meeting passed by unanimous vote at 7:32PM.
