

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 13, 2003**

In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaugh Regional High School on Tuesday, May 13, 2003. At 7:28PM, Moderator Arthur F. Dionne noted a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. Town Clerk Beverly J. Litchfield read the call of the meeting.

ARTICLE 1. -Parliamentary Procedure: Finance Committee Recommends. Passing by a majority vote that the Town adopt special parliamentary procedures for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980 (Proposition 2½) as amended, and as set forth in a document entitled "Article 1, Exhibit A," on file with the Town Clerk.


ARTICLE 2. -Funding Transfers: Finance Committee Recommends. Passing by a majority vote, Pursuant to Section 33B of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, that the Town transfer the sums of:

- \$48,400 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2003 Budget 210, Police Salaries to the FY 2003 Budgets 113, Town Meeting Salaries (\$2,025), 113, Town Meeting Expenses (\$900), 122, Selectmen's Office Salaries (\$3,400), 122, Selectmen's Office Expenses (\$650), 173, Board of Appeals Expenses (\$60), 192, Town Properties Expenses (\$7,843), 199, Town Office Expenses (\$1,109), 240, Central Dispatch Salaries (\$5,500), 251, Inspector Expenses (\$300) and 194, Group Health Insurance (\$26,613);
- \$42,879 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2003 Budgets 134, Accounting Salaries (\$200), 134, Accounting Expenses (\$9,300), 192, Town Properties Salaries (\$5,100), 196, Town Reports Expenses (\$1,361), 220, Fire Expenses (\$5,000), 251, Inspectors Salaries (\$980), 292, Dog Officer Expenses (\$500), 541, Council on Aging Salaries (\$900), 620, Recreation Salaries (\$200), 620, Recreation Expenses (\$815) and 702, Interest on Debt (\$18,523) to the FY 2003 Budget 420, Highway Expenses; and
- \$6,137 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2003 Budget 702, Interest on Debt to the FY 2003 Budget 194, Group Insurance Expenses.

ARTICLE 3. -Stabilization Fund: Finance Committee Recommends. Requiring a 2/3rd vote, passing by a declared 2/3rd vote by the Moderator that the Town appropriate \$29,446 from the Stabilization Fund the FY 2003 Budget 420, Highway Expenses.

ARTICLE 4. **-Receipts Reserved for Appropriation for Ambulance:** Passing by a majority vote to move no action on this article.

Motion to **Dissolve the Special Town Meeting** passed by unanimous vote at 7:40 PM.
