In accordance with the Warrant, as posted, the inhabitants of the Town of Wilbraham, qualified to vote in Town affairs, met in Minnechaug Regional High School on Monday, May 15, 2006. At 7:32 PM Moderator, Arthur F. Dionne noted a quorum was present and called the meeting to order after recessing from the Annual Town Meeting

**ARTICLE 1. -Parliamentary Procedure: Passing by a majority vote** that the Town adopt special parliamentary procedures for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980 (Proposition 2½) as amended, and as set forth in a document entitled "Article 1, Exhibit A," on file with the Town Clerk.

**ARTICLE 2. -Funding Transfers: Passing by a majority vote**, Pursuant to Section 33B of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, that the Town transfer the sums of:

- \$111,326 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2006 Budget 131, Reserve Fund to the FY 2006 Budgets 420, Highway Expenses (\$92,500), 192, Town Properties Expenses (\$7,602) and 210, Police Expenses (\$11,224);
- \$34,240 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2006 Budget 210, Police Salaries to the FY 2006 Budgets 113, Town Meeting Salaries (\$3,266), 113, Town Meeting Expenses (\$2,887), 134, Accounting Salaries (\$500), 138, Treasurer-Collector Salaries (\$350), 163, Registrar Salaries (\$860), 192, Town Properties Expenses (\$11,450), 194, Group Insurance Expenses (\$920), 220, Fire Expenses (\$3,700), 251, Inspector Salaries (\$400), 420, Highway Salaries (\$9,500) and 210, Police Expenses (\$407);
- \$23,000 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2006 Budget 122, Salary Pool to the FY 2006 Budgets 220, Fire Salaries (\$15,300), 702, Interest Expense (\$500), and 210, Police Expense (\$7,200);
- \$6,169 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2006 Budgets 137, Assessors Salaries (\$173), 163, Registrars Expenses (\$500), 179, Planning Salaries (\$941), 192, Town Properties Salaries (\$55), 541, Council on Aging Salaries (\$2,000) and 543, Veterans Salaries (\$2,500) to the FY 2006 Budget 210, Police Expenses.
- \$8,310 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds in the FY 2006 Budget 60-440, Waste Water Enterprise Fund Expenses to the FY 2006 Budget 60-440, Waste Water Enterprise Fund Salaries.

**ARTICLE 3. -Police Extra Duty Detail Revolving Fund: Passing by unanimous vote** that the Town appropriate \$3,964 from previously appropriated but unexpended funds from the FY 2006 Budget 210, Police Salaries to the Police Extra Duty Detail Revolving Fund pursuant to Sections 33B and 53C of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

**ARTICLE 4. –Stabilization Fund: Requiring a 2/3<sup>rd</sup> vote, passing by unanimous vote** for the Town to appropriate \$124,031.11 from federal reimbursements to the Stabilization Fund.


**ARTICLE 5. –Indemnification: Passing by unanimous vote** to move no action on this article.

**ARTICLE 6. –Receipts Reserved for Appropriation for Ambulance: Passing by a majority vote** to move no action on this article.

**ARTICLE 7. –Chapter 90 Appropriation: Passing by unanimous vote** to move no action on this article.

**MOTION –Dissolve Town Meeting: Passing by unanimous vote** that the Special Town Meeting be dissolved and return to the Annual Town meeting.
